Most Barn Hunt competitors are model guests, but it is becoming increasingly difficult to find motels that will accept pets due to bad experiences with excessive barking by dogs. Please do your part to make it possible to have tests in the future. Never leave your dogs(s) unattended in a motel room and please clean up after them. Your entry in future tests may be affected by failure to abide by these rules.

DIRECTIONS TO COMPETITIVE EDGE:

FROM SOUTH: From I-65N take KY-1747 (exit 125, Fern Valley Rd). Go approx. 3.6 miles, turn left onto Shepherdsville Rd, KY-2052. Go another 1.9 miles and **CEA** will be on your left.

FROM NORTH: From I-65S take I-264E (exit 131A Watterson Expressway), take KY-1703S (Exit 15 Newburgh Rd), Turn left on Indian Trail, turn right onto Shepherdsville Rd. **CEA** will be on your right

FROM EAST: From 64W, take US-31E/US-150 (Exit 16 Bardstown Rd.), keep left at the fork, follow Bardstown Rd S, turn right onto Hikes Lane, turn left onto KY-2052 Shepherdsville Road. **CEA** will be on your right.

FROM WEST: From 64E, take I-264E to (Exit 15 Newburgh Rd), Turn left on Indian Trail, turn right onto Shepherdsville Rd. **CEA** will be on your right.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee or Barn Hunt Association, LLC.
- Entries made without fees or signature will not be accepted.
- Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms.
- No entry will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, and act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other causes beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Refunds are available for injured dogs if notification is made before the trial runs and a vet note is presented. Notification must be made to the test chairman/secretary within 30 minutes before the start of the test or earlier.
- Dogs must be leashed or crated when not working. There is crating space available on site. Please make sure your crates are safe and secure as the dogs may be very excited. If your dog is overly excited, please do not leave him/her unattended.
- Dogs should be brought to the ring wearing collars/harnesses which can be easily and quickly removed and replaced. Dogs may NOT be brought to the gate in any disallowed collars or on a Flexi lead. Dogs MUST run “naked”, i.e. without a collar or harness.
- Electronic collars and/or devices, head halters or flexi leads are not allowed in the building. Approved collars include flat snap or buckle of solid construction and leather or nylon leads. Limited slip martingale, single piece slip collars/leads and harnesses are allowed.
- Dogs will run in height order from small to large with dogs being handled by the same person separated into differently staged groups.
- Bitches in season are allowed but will run at the end of each class regardless of height. BIS must compete in panties specifically designed for the purpose of preventing/containing seasonal discharges. BIS must be crated separately from other dogs in an isolated area. A “Bitch In Season” sign must be affixed to the crate or displayed close by the crating area. Owners of BIS must inform the trial chair of their status as soon as possible; prior to the event if known. BIS must wear pants at all times when out of their crates except when being pottied. BIS must be pottied separately from the other dogs at the trial.
- Dogs of any breed or mix, 6 months or older may participate in Barn Hunt Trials. The only limitation is that dog must be able to fit through an 18”wide by 22” high “tunnel” made of straw/hay bales and have useable vision.
- It is suggested that exhibitors bring their own chairs.
- Please use tarps under your crates.
- There are numerous fast food restaurants in a 1-3 mile range.

Description of Volunteer Jobs

Gate Steward: Responsible for calling, getting the dogs on and off of the course and making sure the gate is open and closed promptly.

Staging Steward: Responsible for calling the groups into the blind and sending the dogs to the gate when it is time.

Timer: Times the dog on the course and relates it to the judge

Course Builder: Helps build courses based on the judge's layout. You need to be able to move hay bales.

Sheet Runner: Takes the score sheets to the secretary.

Leash Wrangler: Takes the leash and collar/halter from handler and places it by the exit.

Rat Wrangler: Responsible for removing the rat tube from the course if needed so the dog can finish obstacles.
