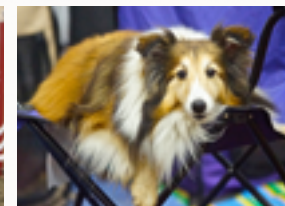
SHOW - N - GO:
